

Sanpaku Eyes

Sanpaku refers to eyes that have more scleral visibility. This can mean that more white is visible above or below the iris.

The lower eyelid may sag and display more white due to the natural aging process. In Yin sanpaku (lower scleral show), the sclera portion below the iris is visible.

The scleral show is an anatomical condition that can be inherited from your parents, or it may appear later in life as your facial structure changes shape.

This condition does not go away with age. Therefore, the real Sister Lucy WITH IT, could not be the older imposter Sister Lucy WITHOUT IT.

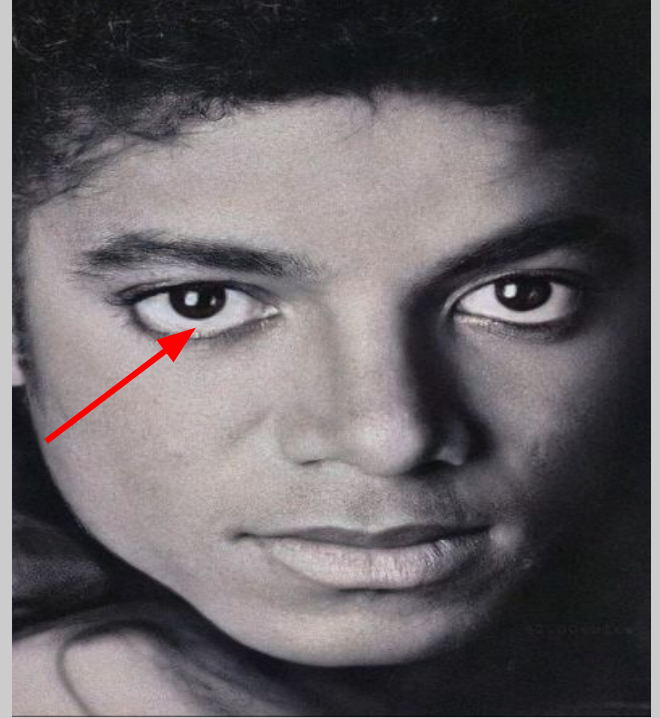
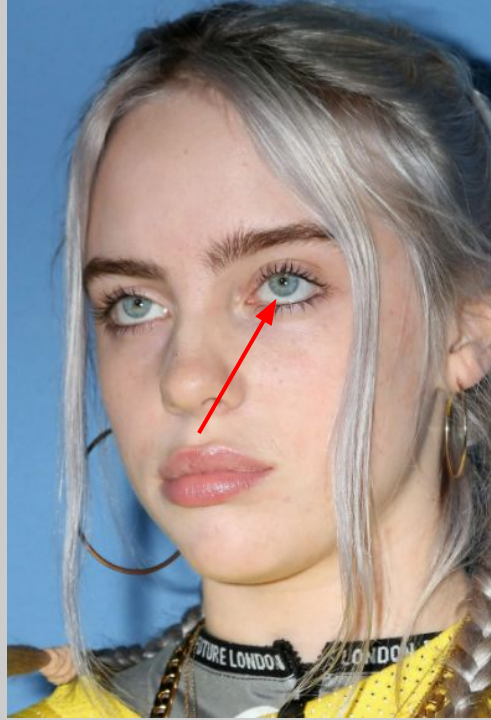
Normal Eye

You can clearly see the white of her sclera under her iris as she looks straight at the camera.

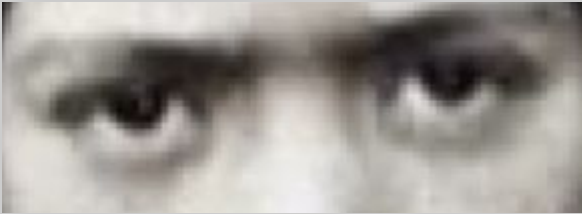


In this picture of the real Sister Lucy in her 30s you can see the white of the sclera under the iris.
